Voluntary School Contribution Fees Policy

Introduction:

School contributions are voluntary. They help provide additional educational resources for the benefit of students. It is a one off payment that will help your child with achieving educational outcomes.

Objectives

- All schools can request contributions to enhance their educational and sporting programs.
- School contributions are voluntary and payment is a matter for decision by parents.
- There will be no charge to fulfill the minimum requirements of the curriculum.
- Schools may charge students for elective subjects that go beyond the minimum requirements of the curriculum.
- Parents who are unable to pay for elective subjects because of financial hardship may be eligible for assistance from the Student Assistance Scheme or other appropriate sources.
- Principals will ensure that no student or family suffers any discrimination or embarrassment over failure to make a voluntary or subject contribution. Confidentiality, privacy and dignity must always be maintained concerning contributions.
- Principals will adhere to the Code of Practice relating to school contributions.

Process:

Parents are asked to do the following:

- Fill out the front of the envelope, available at the front office and distributed to families at the beginning of the school year.
- Place the appropriate money in the envelope.
