NAPLAN

2021 NAPLAN tests: 11 - 21 May 2021

Students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 will sit for the National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) test in May. The assessments are an opportunity for students to demonstrate what they have learned in class. Teachers use these results to meet the individual literacy and numeracy needs of all students.

There are four tests covering language conventions (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and writing, reading and numeracy. If students are absent, they have the ability to make up the test on or before Friday 21 May.

All the tests will be completed online except for the Year 3 writing assessment.

Important dates in the application process are as follows:

Tuesday 26 April 2022: Online applications opens

Friday 13 May 2022: Online applications closes (Parents and carers must apply by the due date.)

Thursday 28 July 2022: Opportunity Class Placement Test

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 5 opportunity class entry in 2023, you need to apply between **Tuesday 26 April 2022** and **Friday 13 May 2022**.
